Mentoring Program for Land Development Engineering Professionals aspiring to be Future Leaders within the Industry

Mentoring Program Overview

A selection of the ALDE Executive Board’s senior professionals will act as mentors for early career professionals seeking to get exposure to liaising with authorities in framing and reviewing policy. Participants will have the opportunity to broaden industry networks, attend selected board meetings, participate/ coordinate industry events as well as learn new skills and gain the knowledge required to progress as tomorrow’s leaders.

Who is it for?

Early career professionals with 3-8 years of experience in the land development industry to apply (diverse entries are strongly supported and encouraged). Participants should ideally have attended Yield/ ALDE event/s or are involved with the Yield committee.

Program Framework

The ALDE Mentoring Program begins with a launch event, a mid-program catch-up prior to an ALDE event and concludes with a closing event. Between these two bookend networking events, the program provides involvement with regular ALDE subcommittee meetings where you will work towards shaping the direction of the industry.
